


Halloween Safety Tips Covid 19

KINDERGARTEN APPLICATIONS





How Parents Can Help Keep St. Helen's School Safe

School staff are working very hard to follow Public Health Rules and Guidelines. The students are doing an excellent job adjusting to the many protocols we have put in place. We need the support of the parents to ensure our school remains safe.

- 1. Pack your child's lunch in the morning and avoid dropping off lunches or picking up your child for lunch. Please remember to pack your child's water bottles and forks/spoons as we do not give out cups and utensils at the office.
