Dear Parents and Students,

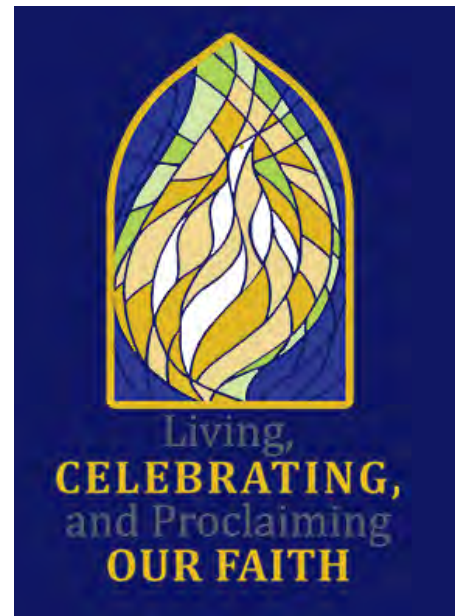

This will directly notify both the office staff and teacher of your child's absence

If your child arrives late to school after 9 am, it is the parents responsibility to check them into the office and we will walk the child to the their classroom if needed.

Over the summer, I collaborated with Sister Magdalen and Sister Claire to create crosses for the new modular school, using large beams salvaged from the old school. Sister Magdalen meticulously handcrafted the figures of Jesus for each cross, while Mr. Diego Campanile cut the beams and assembled the crosses. We now have two additional crosses available for auction, with proceeds dedicated to furnishing the new facility. These crosses, made from 100-year-old wood, hold deep significance in our Catholic school community. Crafted by the sisters and principal, they represent a strong connection to our faith, honoring Catholic traditions throughout the school year. By placing these crosses in the new modular classrooms, we pay tribute to the continuity of our Catholic values and education, linking the past to the future of our school's spiritual journey.

We have six modular classrooms, and we would like to recognize every student and their family by engraving the student or family's name on the back of a cross. We are requesting donations, with a recommended amount of \$100. All contributions will go toward furniture and resources for the new classrooms, such as touchscreens, shelving, and an outdoor classroom area between the modular buildings. More information will be provided by your homeroom teachers.

The cross is present in every aspect of our daily life - in sickness, poverty, tiredness, tensions with others, professional challenges. Through the cross, Jesus has taught us to turn our pain into glory.
